ADJECTIVES – ADVERBS OF MANNER - VERBS OF SENSES

A. PUT THE VERBS IN THE CORRECT ORDER

REMEMBER!!! Τα επίθετα χωρίζονται σε δυο κατηγορίες στα *opinion adjectives* (beautiful, bad κ.λπ.) τα οποία εκφράζουν την προσωπική μας γνώμη, και στα *fact adjectives* (long, strong, old κ.λπ.) τα οποία δίνουν μια αντικειμενική περιγραφή δηλαδή περιγράφουν πως είναι κάτι στην πραγματικότητα.

Order of Adjectives

- Τα *Opinion Adjectives* μπαίνουν μπροστά από τα fact adjectives e.g. a beautiful young woman
- Όταν έχουμε δυο ή περισσότερα *fact adjectives* σε μια πρόταση, τότε ακολουθούμε συνήθως την εξής σειρά:

Size – Age – Shape – Colour – Origin – Material – Noun

A small new square green French woollen rug

- Σπάνια έχουμε ένα μεγάλο αριθμό επιθέτων πριν από ένα μόνο ουσιαστικό. Συνήθως ένα ουσιαστικό προσδιορίζεται από ένα, δυο ή το πολύ τρία επίθετα.

An expensive Venetian crystal vase

BE CAREFULL!!!

Τα επίθετα μπαίνουν μπροστά από τα ουσιαστικά (a tall girl). Μπορούν να μπουν **μετά** από το ρήμα to be και από τα ρήματα: look, taste, smell, sound, feel
