## A. PUT THE VERBS IN THE CORRECT ORDER

## Order of Adjectives

- Τα Opinion Adjectives μπαίνουν μπροστά από τα fact adjectives e.g. a beautiful young woman
- Όταν έχουμε δυο ή περισσότερα fact adjectives σε μια πρόταση, τότε ακολουθούμε συνήθως την εξής σειρά:

Συνήθως ένα ουσιαστικό προσδιορίζεται από ένα, δυο ή το πολύ τρία επίθετα.

Τα επίθετα μπαίνουν μπροστά από τα ουσιαστικά ( a tall girl ). Μπορούν να μπουν μετά από το ρήμα to be και από τα ρήματα: look, taste, smell, sound, feel
